DISABILITY SWIMMING CHAMPIONSHIPS CONDITIONS

These supplementary conditions are to be adhered to in conjunction with the general conditions for the Regional Championships.

1. The Events:

50m, 100m and 200m Freestyle S1 – S14
400 Freestyle S6 - S14
50m Backstroke S1 - S14
100m Backstroke S6 - S14
50m Breaststroke SB1 - SB9, SB11 - SB14
100m Breaststroke SB4 - SB9, SB11 - SB14
50m Butterfly S1 - S14
100m Butterfly S8 - S14
150m Individual Medley SM1 - SM4
200m & †400 Individual Medley SM5 - SM14

† Where no Standard Entry Time is shown, the swimmer must have achieved the qualification standard for the 200m Individual Medley

2. Eligibility

Competitors must provide a copy (both sides) of their Functional Ability Card (FAC) at the time of entry
Qualification times must have been achieved after October 1st 2009
Competitors must be a minimum of 10 years of age as at 13th June 2010

3. Accreditation

Coaches and personal care attendants must have an accreditation. Personal care attendants will only be permitted, in accordance with IPC guidelines, for competitors in the following classes S1, S2, S3 and S11. Such attendants will be excluded from any restrictions and will be given the same accreditation as the competitor for whom they have personal care responsibilities. A competitor in the above classifications may have both a coach and a personal care attendant in attendance. All coaches will be required to purchase a coach pass. NO PASS, NO ACCESS TO THE POOL DECK.

4. Medals

Medals shall be awarded on a multi-disability timed final basis to 1st, 2nd and 3rd placed competitors based on British Disability Points regardless of age. If less than four swimmers participate in any one event then a minus one ruling shall apply. If only one swimmer participates in any event, then the swimmer may, at the discretion of the event organiser, be awarded a medal providing he/she improves upon their entry time.
