

Swim England East Region

General Diving Event Conditions

East Region (Level 2) Skills Event:

- The competitions shall be conducted in accordance with Swim England Regulations and Technical Rules and F.I.N.A. Technical Rules for Diving.
- There shall be separate events for males and females.
- All ages are as at the 31st December in the year of competition.
- All competitions shall be promoted as 'Open' events with two separate entry categories.
- An individual entry for both entry categories will not be accepted.
- An entrant for a competition must be a Swim England registered category 2 member of the club they are representing or a Temporary Member of Swim England by the published closing date.
- A published 'Event Entry Pack' will give specific event conditions, test requirements and general event information.

Entry Categories:

East Region Entries

- Will be accepted from divers who are registered members of clubs affiliated to a Swim England East Region.
- An entered diver shall not have competed in the closed championships or competitions of another Swim England Region in the same year other than as an individual member of a synchronised pair.

Guest Entries

- Entries will be accepted from divers who are registered members of any club affiliated to Swim England through their Regional Association, the Scottish ASA or Welsh ASA or one of the countries affiliated to F.I.N.A.

Medals:

- Medals will be presented to the top three competitors from the East Region entries.
- A guest competitor who is ranked in the first three places in the overall results will receive an appropriate commemorative medal.

Eligibility:

Is 'open' to a Swim England East Region or Guest diver who has not previously entered:

- The Armada Cup, G-Star, Luton Challenge or Southampton Invitational.
- An individual National or Regional Age Group (level 3) competition except when moving from group C to group B.
- A British, National, Regional or Club Junior Elite (level 4) or Senior (level 5) competition.
- Any synchronised diving competition at levels 4 or 5.
- An entry from a diver who had previously competed in a higher level of competition as specified above will only be accepted with the prior written authority of the East Region Diving Manager.

Please Note:

Coaches entering divers of an inappropriate standard in any East Region Diving Event may be approached by the Regional Diving Manager and given advice on competition selection.

East Region (Level 3) Age Groups Event:

- The competitions shall be conducted in accordance with Swim England Regulations and Technical Rules and F.I.N.A. Technical Rules for Diving.
- There shall be separate events for males and females.
- All ages are as at the 31st December in the year of competition.
- All competitions shall be promoted as 'Open' events with two separate entry categories.
- An individual entry for both entry categories will not be accepted.
- An entrant for a competition must be a Swim England registered category 2 member of the club they are representing or a Temporary Member of Swim England by the published closing date.
- A published 'Event Entry Pack' will give specific event conditions, test requirements and general event information.

Entry Categories:

East Region Entries

- Will be accepted from divers who are registered members of clubs affiliated to Swim England East Region.
- An entered diver shall not have competed in the closed championships or competitions of another Region of Swim England in the same year other than as an individual member of a synchronised pair.

Guest Entries

- Will be accepted from divers who are registered members of any club affiliated to Swim England through their Regional Association, Scottish Swimming, Swim Wales or one of the countries affiliated to F.I.N.A.

Medals:

- Medals will be presented to the top three competitors from the East Region entries.
- A guest competitor who is ranked in the first three places in the overall results will receive an appropriate commemorative medal.

Eligibility:

- Is 'open' to a Swim England East Region or Guest diver who has not previously entered:
- An individual competition at a British, National, Regional or Club Elite (level 4) event on a particular board.
- Any individual or synchronised competition at a British, National or Regional or Club Senior (level 5) event.
- An entry from a diver who had previously competed in a higher level of competition as specified above will only be accepted with the prior written authority of the East Region Diving Manager.

Coaches entering divers of an inappropriate standard in any East Region Diving Event may be approached by the Regional Diving Manager and given advice on competition selection.

East Region Elite (Level 4) and Senior (Level 5) Events:

- The events shall be conducted separately in accordance with Swim England Regulations and Technical Rules and

F.I.N.A. Technical Rules for Diving.

- There shall be separate events for males, females and mixed teams.
- Elite (Level 4) competitions are as defined in FINA Age Group Rule DAG3.
- Senior (Level 5) competitions are as defined in FINA Rule D3.
- All ages are as at the 31st December in the year of competition.
- All competitions shall be promoted as 'Open' events with separate entry categories.
- An individual entry for more than one age group category will not be accepted.
- An entrant for a competition must be a Swim England registered category 2 member of the club they are representing or a Temporary Member of Swim England by the published closing date.
- A published 'Event Entry Pack' will give specific event conditions, test requirements and general event information.

Entry Categories:

East Region Entries

- Will be accepted from divers who are registered members of clubs affiliated to Swim England East Region.
- An entered diver shall not have competed in the closed championships or competitions of another Region of Swim England in the same year other than as an individual member of a synchronised pair.

Guest Entries

- Will be accepted from divers who are registered members of any club affiliated to Swim England through their Regional Association, Scottish Swimming, Swim Wales or one of the countries affiliated to F.I.N.A.

Medals:

- Medals will be presented to the top three competitors from the East Region entries.
- A guest competitor who is ranked in the first three places in the overall results will receive an appropriate commemorative medal.

Eligibility:

These events are 'open':

- Entries will be accepted from Group 'C' divers or above with the exception of one diver from a synchronised pairing.
- An entry from a diver below Group 'C' will not be accepted without the prior written authority of the East Region Diving Manager,

East Region Club Championships:

- The competitions shall be conducted in accordance with Swim England Regulations and Technical Rules and F.I.N.A. Technical Rules for Diving.
- There shall be separate individual competitions for males and females.
- All ages are as at the 31st December in the year of competition.
- All competitions shall be promoted as 'Open' events with two separate entry categories.
- An individual entry for both entry categories will not be accepted.

January 2020

- An entrant for a competition must be a Swim England registered category 2 member of the club they are representing or a Temporary Member of Swim England by the published closing date.
- A junior diver may dive up to senior level but may not dive in both junior and senior categories.

Entry Categories:

East Region Entries

- Will be accepted from divers who are registered members of clubs affiliated to Swim England East Region.
- An entered diver shall not have competed in the closed championships or competitions of another Region of Swim England in the same year other than as an individual member of a synchronised pair.

Guest Entries

- Will be accepted from divers who are registered members of any club affiliated to Swim England through their Regional Association, Scottish Swimming, Swim Wales or one of the countries affiliated to F.I.N.A.

Medals / Club Trophy:

- Medals will be presented to the top three competitors from the East Region entries.
- A guest competitor who is ranked in the first three places in the overall results will receive an appropriate commemorative medal.
- A 'Regional Club Trophy' will be presented to the ASA East Region club with the most accumulated points from the first six individual placed competitors in the East Region Club Championships, i.e. excluding synchronised diving competitions.
- Accumulated points will be allocated as follows: 12 points 1st place, 10 points 2nd place, 8 points 3rd place, 6 points 4th place, 4 points 5th place, 2 points 6th place.

Eligibility:

- These competitions are 'open' to a Swim England East Region or Guest diver without affecting the diver's National or Regional Level 2, 3, 4 or 5 status.
