19/03 Previous Minutes

19/03.1 Minutes dated 19<sup>th</sup> November 2018 were circulated in advance of the meeting and were accepted as an accurate record, which were approved by the committee.

#### 19/05 Athlete Recognition

19/05.1 Fourteen-year-old Ellie Challis (Colchester Phoenix SC), broke the 50m Breaststroke SB2 British Record at the National Para Swim Meet in Manchester in a time of 1:11.53. Ellie was comfortably inside the previous record by 3 seconds which had stood for 26 years. Well done Ellie.

Although early in the season, there were strong swims from Regional swimmers with lots of personal best times.

#### 19/06 County Reports

19/06.1 **Bedfordshire:** Regional Training has been arranged for 11<sup>th</sup> May 2019, at Flitwick. There are no QT's for Para athletes entering Beds County Championships. Athlete's classification class will not appear on the programmes. Medals are awarded.

19/06.2 Cambridgeshire: Currently there are no QT's for Para athletes entering Cambridgeshire County Championships, but the setting QT's is being considered, recognising that para athletes wish to be treated like their abled bodied peers.

JH to attend a County Meeting with PD to promote and develop Disability swimming in Cambridgeshire clubs.

19/06.3 **Essex:** JC to attend Swimming Committee meeting where Disability swimming is an agenda item.



19/06.4 **Hertfordshire:** There are County Championships QT's for Para swimmers and 2 swimmers have entered.

23<sup>rd</sup> February 2019: Regional training session will include talk with Para-athlete Louise Fiddes and land training for both Coaches and athletes delivered by Steve Batchelor. Incorporated in the Coach Development Day is the CPD – 'Coaching the Person In Front Of You' which has a Disability component, and Janet Warrington will deliver 'Integrating Autistic Swimmers' seminar.

IM highlighted that strobes will be required at all licensed meets from 2020. He also warned of taking care of strobes and not leaving them at poolside after meets and ensuring that they were dry. A local club needed to repair a strobe after it corroded.
