- Qualified for at least one event at the 2022 East Region Long Course Championships or associated Development Event
- Planning on competing at the forthcoming East Region Open Water Championships on 10th
 July 2022 at Whitlingham Lakes, or similar event

Hints and Tips For Clubs This Month

 For those that require a safeguarding workshop certificate as part of your role, please do not forget to upload your certificate as soon as it is received. You need to upload it onto your Swim England record at www.swimmingresults.org via the Members tab, then Member Options. Once you have logged in you can upload your certificate here.



- When your club updates it's club constitution (via working with our <u>Membership Officer</u>) it must be approved by your members at an AGM/ SGM and the minutes of this meeting must be submitted to the region, along with a list of members in attendance, and their membership numbers. A certificate cannot be issued without this.
- Executive Officers should be identified on the Online Membership System as 'Organisation' under their roles. If they are only listed under a specific discipline, they may not receive important correspondance from Swim England throughout the year.
