British Swimming/Swim England updates

- 22/24.1 DM at the last minute was unable to attend the last Swim England SOG meeting which was held on 9 June 22 as he was running the WPS World Championships in Madeira. Gerry Metcalf, a SE ER ROC member, attended in his place.
- 22/24.2 **SE Guidance on Water Depths – Diving into Swimming Pools and Competitive Starts**
Swim England published a policy document on 28 April 22 which referred to racing starts and shallow dives which recommended a minimum depth of 1.35m.

This was recently published but then withdrawn to allow for a period of consultation over the effect on facilities. The Swim England Swimming Leadership Group, SE SOG, Pool Operators, Coaches etc had no consultation from the team who had implemented the changes.

The process is now under a full review and consultation by the Swim England Swimming Operations Committee.
- 22/24.3 **Considerations for Alternatives for Official’s Dress Code (Swimming)**
The SE SOG were asked to review official’s uniforms which promotes volunteering as technical officials due to correspondence being received by the SE SLG.

Discussions took place regarding the wearing of black or white trousers/skirt but must still wear a white coloured top. Various levels of gala requirements were considered.

Only one letter of concern had been received and the SOG members were asked to send their views to HA for collation and further decision and consultation.
- 22/24.4 **SE Open Meet Licensing Criteria Official’s Requirements**
With effect from 11 March 22, Swim England updated their guidance following a return to normal following the Covid restrictions.

British Swimming have updated the post qualification hours required before commencement of training for Judge level 2/2S from 15 to 20 hours. The joint course fee also rose from £8 to £10. This was effective from 1 April 2022.

22/26.1 Fina Rules Update 2017 – BS Official's Licence Renewal

There is no further update to FINA Rules, a new version is expected early 2023.

Any official who has already attended a 2017 update or recently qualified under the current rules do not require attending another CPD to renew their licence. All County Coordinators to pass this on to licensed referees within their counties.

22/26.2 Judge Level 1 Online Training Extensions

11 months to complete training, the only time this will be extended, the extension must be in writing, explaining the issues that has prevented them from completing their training. They will be required to forward their training record and advise where and when they will complete, including details of galas to attend.

Any licensed referee can sign off the Judge Level 1 competencies, including the final completion of all BS/SE requirements.

22/26.3 **Virtual delivery of Judge level 2/Judge Level 2S (starter) courses by Counties within the Region**
DM thanked those County Coordinators who had already volunteered to assist in the running of online courses.

A list of dates and the regional processes going forward had been produced and circulated. The document will be placed on the regional website showing the dates and type of course. It is intended to be a live document with dates being added as the year progresses.
