Conditions

- **1** All entrants must be Club Compete (category 2) members of a Swim England, SASA or WASA affiliated club or competitors from a country affiliated to FINA.
- **2** Age as at 31st December in the year of competition.
- **3** Entries will be accepted on a 'first come first served' basis, based on day of receipt.
- **4** Results will be split into the following age groups 16-24, 25-29 and then 5 year age groups as necessary with the final group being 70yrs+.
- **5** All events will be Heat Declared Winners. 'Over the top' starts will be used wherever possible.
- 6 Awards will be made to the fastest 3 swimmers in each age group and each event as follows: Commemorative medals for non Suffolk swimmers, Suffolk County medals for eligible Suffolk swimmers. There will be awards for non-Suffolk clubs and swimmers for the Top Visiting Club, Top Male and Top Female based on 6 points for 1st place down to 1 point for 6th place. There will also be David Robinson Masters Memorial awards for Top Suffolk Club, Top Suffolk Male and Top Suffolk Female based on 6 points for 1st place down to 1 point for 6th. Masters awards defined as 25+ age groups. In the event of a tie, the Promoters decision will be final.
- **7** To be eligible for Suffolk County Medals, swimmers must have a Suffolk club as their Ranked Club and must not represent another County or compete in another County's Championships in the same calendar year.
- **8** Events may be swum with men & women seeded together, depending on the number of entries received, but there will be separate results produced for all combined events.
- **9** Heats for each event will cover all age groups and competitors. Events will be seeded slowest to fastest, based on entry time submitted. Each heat will be spearheaded. The Promoter reserves the right to modify the seeding arrangements should conditions demand.
- **10** Warm up protocol: Each warm up session will be divided into equal length sessions. There is to be strictly no diving during warm up, with the exception of designated sprint lanes. Odd lanes will swim clockwise and even lanes will swim anti-clockwise. Swimmers must leave the water by the side of the pool and not over the timing pads.
- **11** Results will be posted on the club website and will be supplied to British Swimming for entry into the Masters rankings database.
- **12** The pool is a 25m 6 lane pool with anti-turbulence lane ropes and full electronic timing. The depth of water at the starting end is 1.4m and at the turn end is 0.9m. The height of the starting blocks above the surface of the water is 650mm. A secondary strobe for the starting system is not available.

- 14 Accepted entries will be posted on the club's website soon after the closing date.
- **15** We will be a using a secondary signing in system on the day and will assume that any entries left blank are due to the competitor either not being at the meet or has chosen not to swim that particular event and they will be withdrawn before the finalised start sheets are produced.
- **16** Entry fees will be **£5.50** per event.
- 17 CLOSING DATE FOR ENTRIES IS SATURDAY 10th FEBRUARY 2024 or when the meet is full, all entries and payment must be received by the closing date.
