Important Notice – Session 1 (Mixed 800m Freestyle)

Historically, the regional 800m Freestyle session has taken place on the Friday night before a 14/under weekend.

This year, it is taking place the night before a 15+ and Para Swimming weekend.

To give the 15+ swimmers maximum rest in advance of their weekend of racing, the 800m Freestyle heats will be seeded as normal but the heats will be swum in reverse order. The highest numbered heat will be swum first with heat 1 being the last to be swum.
