Role Purpose: To provide leadership and direction to the Board of Directors

Summary

Swim England East Region is a company limited by guarantee with charitable status. In addition to being Chairman of the Board of Directors, the Regional Chairman is a company director and Trustee of the charity, and shares the responsibilities of those roles with other directors. In addition, the Regional Chairman has the following specific responsibilities:

Responsibilities

- Ensure that the highest standards of governance are followed and that the Company acts in accordance with its Articles of Association and Regulations
- Chair Board meetings, Annual General Meetings and Regional Operations Committee meetings
- Provide leadership and direction to the Board ensuring that agendas are appropriate and that the Board has relevant information in order to make decisions
- To line manage the Regional Manager
- Develop a four year regional strategy to reflect key priorities
- To oversee the delivery of the Regional Strategic plan, ensuring that it is compatible with the plans of Swim England
- Ensure that the Board develops regional plans and budgets and monitors and evaluates these to maintain a sound financial platform at all times
- Take appropriate steps to ensure that the Board members' skill and contribution levels are maximised
- Review and approval of all regional policies
- Ensure adherence to relevant Swim England Policies including its Equity and Child Protection policies
- Be a point of contact for regional officers and discipline managers
- Liaise with the other regional chairmen and Swim England Senior Management Team as appropriate, including attendance at meetings of the Regional Chairmen's Group
- Be a champion of swimming in all its disciplines, and be an ambassador for the region at every opportunity
