Club Reports

24/43.1

Luton

BL reported lots of new starters at the club. Admin system had been streamlined introducing google docs for membership forms etc. A new bubbles machine had been installed late July and summer squad training was going well. Assistant Head Coach Jack Tempest had also started to stamp his own influence on the club making changes to the programme. BL reported the continued need for more coaching courses including a wish to secure 2 under 16s onto an Assistance Coaching course if possible.

Cambridge

AJ reported increased level of enquires for new starters at the club associated with Team GB success at Olympics. Summer camps were ongoing also with good attendance levels. Tadhg Owers had now decided to begin university in 2024 and the club would be looking for creative ways to secure a third coach enabling further growth. Swim Mark reaccreditation preparations were set to begin at the end Q3 2024.

Dacorum

SL reported that the club was back to their own pool for training but that some limited training continued at Amersham (1 to 2 days per week) as the bubbles at Hemel Hempstead were still out of action. Diver numbers were healthy and the club was hoping to send one under 16 participant to the upcoming Assistant Coaching course at Cambridge.

Southend

SL reported that the club had had its most successful season for many years. Having the Australian and Malaysian Olympic teams on site for training with viewing access to the public too had also been inspirational for divers. The planned fulcrum replacements were now completed.

Operations Update

24/44.1

LT had circulated budget papers in advance of the meeting. SB reported her confidence that finances were healthy as regional events had produced good surpluses but that overall figures reported currently did not yet reflect all costs incurred so far as pool hire invoices were still missing.

LT also reported that some expenditure planned for regional development had not been incurred as activities had been pushed out until later in the calendar year. The next development activity hosted in Southend would concentrate on preparing divers for Talent Games and the new conditions for this year's event.
