Event Photography and Filming

Events will be photographed and may be live streamed. Static images may be displayed on the Swim England East Region website www.eastswimming.org and at the venue. They may also be used to promote the sport at this event and events in the future.

Moving images may be displayed at the venue and via a live stream (subject to the event being live streamed). In addition, the Swim England East Region may use recordings and images for the purposes of education and training, diver analysis, promotion, performance, development and selection and event analysis.

In such instances where the event is being live streamed, it will not be possible to provide the option to refuse consent to filming. If there are any concerns about live streaming, moving or static images being taken please speak to the Swim England East Region Event Coordinator present at the event.

If you intend to take photographs or video images at this event, please remember:

- Do not circulate images of an individual(s) without their consent.

General Event Conditions:

- The competitions shall be conducted in accordance with Swim England Regulations and World Aquatic Technical Rules for Diving, except where set out in these conditions.
- There shall be separate individual competitions for the open and female categories.
- All events will be a straight final.
- All ages are as at the 31st December in the year of competition.
- All competitions shall be promoted as 'Open' events with two separate entry categories.
- An individual entry for both entry categories will not be accepted.
- An entrant for a competition must be a Swim England registered Club Compete member of the club they are representing or a Temporary Member of Swim England by the published closing date.

Entry Categories:

East Region Entries

- Will be accepted from divers who are registered members of clubs affiliated to a Swim England East Region.
- An entered diver shall not have competed in the closed championships or competitions of another Swim England Region in the same year other than as an individual member of a synchronised pair.

Guest Entries

- Entries will be accepted from divers who are registered members of any club affiliated to Swim England through their Regional Association, the Scottish Swimming or Swim Wales or one of the countries affiliated to World Aquatics.

Medals:

- Medals will be presented to the top three competitors from the East Region entries.
- A guest competitor who is ranked in the first three places in the overall results will receive an appropriate commemorative medal.

Please Note:

Coaches entering divers of an inappropriate standard in any East Region Diving Event may be approached by the Regional Diving Manager and given advice on competition selection.

Competition Conditions:

All ages are at the 31st December in the year of competition.

The East Regional Elite Junior Diving Championships event conditions will adhere to World Aquatic Age Group Conditions with the exception of the following Group C events specific clauses:

- Group C Events are 13 years and under in the year of competition.
- Girls Group C compete 3 optional dives from 3 groups in all events.
- *C Platform Divers aged 11 years and under are allowed to compete on 7.5m, however it is the responsibility of the coach and diver to ensure the divers physical maturity and strength permit competing from a height of 7.5m.

No repeat dives are permitted. Dives of the same number are considered to be a repeat, even in a different shape.

Please Note:

¹National Standard - For your information we have published the points required to meet the recommended National Standard. The publishing of these points does not imply you are required to meet this standard to dive in this Regional competition nor would achieving these points confer an automatic qualification to the British Elite Junior Diving Championships.

Eligibility:

1. A Swim England East Region or Guest diver who has achieved the British Elite Junior Championships Performance Standard at a Regional or Open Club Elite (level 4) competition in the same calendar year as the British Elite Junior Diving Championships for which it is recommended, is not eligible to compete at the East Region Age Groups (level 3) and East Region Skills Event (level 2) whilst in that age category.
2. Once a diver has competed in the Swim England East Region Elites competition in any event, they are not eligible to compete at the East Region Skills Event (level 2).
3. Once a diver achieves the minimum Performance Standard on any board at a Regional or Open Club event in the same calendar year as the national event for which it is recommended, that diver must remain at that level of competition in the pathway or above, whilst in that age category.
